

**McCracken County Community Career Endowment Launches *Need a Job? Fair***

In its continuing effort to expand the pool of more diverse and qualified job candidates for our local business community, the McCracken County Community Career Endowment (MCCCE) will host its first **Need a Job? Fair, 10 a.m.-2 p.m., Saturday, Aug. 11, at Paducah Middle School, 342 Lone Oak Rd.**

The event is open to anyone looking for a job — including those employed but interested in pursuing other opportunities.

Participants attending two workshops during this event will receive one credit hour from West Kentucky Community & Technical College.

From 10 a.m. to noon, the MCCCE staff and local human resource experts will assist job seekers with career assessments and other employment tips. These one-on-one and small group sessions will help job seekers connect their skills and interests with available opportunities, and identify and fill any skill gaps.

A complimentary lunch will be served from 12-12:30 p.m.

Then from 12:30-2 p.m., job seekers will hear first-hand from a cross-section of people employed in this area's "hottest" jobs, including nurses, carpenters and welders.

Door prizes will be drawn throughout the day and free childcare is available by calling 270-444-6962 — please call ahead of time.

The MCCCE staff and board of directors are hopeful that the event draws a large turnout. "Our message to everyone in the African American community is this: If you want a job or if you want a *better* job, we're here to help, regardless of your skill and education levels," Herschel Dungey, MCCCE's Job Bank chair. "There are companies in our area looking for good people at all levels."
